


# DAVID WADE • WISCONSIN

David Wade is seeking election to the NPPC Board of Directors. He is the vice president of The Hanor Company of Wisconsin, LLC, a farrow-to-finish enterprise consisting of 85,000 sows, and one that markets more than two million pigs annually.
